

The Promenade Homeowner's Association pre-approved the following plants as replacements to the original alley grass put in by WPH. This means you can any of the following plants in your ALLEY Property ONLY without having to submit an architectural application for HOA approval. Any other plants still require an architectural application and HOA approval. Many thanks to Susan Tolley for her research on this subject, we have taken her recommendations.

All are suitable for our climate here, some like more sun than others.

Emerald Cushion (*Azorella trifurcata* Nana)
Mini Kenilworth Ivy (*Cymbalaria aequitrilobata*)
Miniature Rush (*Eleocharis radicans*) (looks the most like grass)
Green Carpet (*Herniaria glabra*)
Blue Star Creeper (*Isotoma fluviatilis*)
Corsican Mint (*Mentha requienii*)
Miniature Brass Buttons (*Leptinella gruveri* *Mentha requienii*)
Irish Moss (*Sagina subulata*) (not Scotch Moss, too yellow, mosses can also be a little ratty)
Baby Tears Sedum (*Sedum album chloroticum* baby tears)
Emerald Cushion (*Azorella trifurcata* Nana)
Creeping Boobialla (*Myoporum Parvifolium*)
